Competitors can now compete at more than one height

The format will change of SJ will be shortened at qualifiers, which will allow competitors to enter consecutive heights (excluding 70cm). The Championship format will remain the same.

Riders jump two rounds. Riders will jump the first round and then the second round separately. The second round will be run as a single phase competition, which will combine the second round and the jump-off. The first half of the course should be set at the second round height, with the second part of the course set at jump-off height. The course should be timed in two parts, with the second half being recorded as the jump-off. The jump-off will follow straight on from the first part of the course without stopping. All team and individual members (unless the individual is eliminated in first round) will go forward to the second part of the second round (jump-off) unless eliminated in the first half. The second half of the second round (the jump-off) will be classed as both the team and individual jump-off. This applies to teams and individuals.

Should a team member be eliminated before reaching the jump-off phase in the second round they will **NOT** continue forward to the jump-off section and the team will continue as a team of three.

The Official Steward reserves the right to stop anyone who is in multiple classes if BRC feel the horse's welfare is compromised.

Eligibility in conjunction with CR Appendix 2 & 3. Horses may compete in any competition for which they are eligible in a competition year (1 April to 31 March).

- Upward progression is permitted in the same discipline, for example a horse could do the BRC HT 90 in the summer season and BRC CH 100 in the winter season or a horse could do the 80 show jumping in the summer and move up to 90 show jumping in the winter.
- No horse may compete twice in the same team.
- No horse can be ridden over the same course of jumps on the same day. Juniors and seniors may share horses for show jumping provided the competition is split into senior and junior. In this instance horses for example may compete in the Senior 80 SJ and the Junior 80 SJ or the Senior 80 SJ and the Junior 90 SJ.
- A horse may compete at consecutive heights in show jumping for example a horse may compete in 80cm/90cm classes or 90cm/100cm classes, provided they meet eligibility requirements and only once is as part of a team. Horses competing in the 70cm will not be permitted to compete at any other height in show jumping in the competition year other than upward progression.

Teams can consist of 4 Junior or 4 Senior riders, best 3 scores to count or Teams of 3 may compete, all 3 scores to count. Non qualifying teams may consist of mixed Junior and Senior teams. In-case of over subscription, qualifying teams will take priority.

Entry Fees £50 per team £14 for individuals

All cheques should be made payable to "Quantock Riding Club" and have the name of the team(s) and club printed clearly on the reverse side. One cheque per club please. A charge of $\mathfrak{L}10$ will made for any dishonoured cheques.

Qualifying prelim entries to be made using the official BRC Entry form or website by 20th Jan. Detailed entries to be sent to the Secretary on the BRC Area Entry form or Equo by 3rd Feb.

DECLARATIONS Qualifier declaration sheets to be handed in together with all photocopies of passport/fluvac pages in a clear plastic sleeve (one per team) prior to first horses competing.

Hats must be checked before mounting. Bring to the Secretary when you collect your number if not already tagged with an Orange Tag. See current rulebook / BRC website for details.

ELIGIBILITY AND RULES IMPORTANT

Riders is under 18 on 1st Jan 2018.

Riders may compete in the same class as an individual AND as a team member provided different horses/ponies are ridden.

NO Entry will be accepted without correct and full payment at close of entry, all clubs must also have paid 2018 affiliation fees before entries will be accepted.
